Report on the State of Adult Education in New York State

KEVIN G. SMITH



Deputy Commissioner Smith leads the Office of Adult Career and Continuing Education Services (ACCES). ACCES includes responsibility for New York State's Vocational Rehabilitation office which serves more than 12,000 individuals with disabilities who seek employment. Over 700 employees of NYSED are deployed across the state to provide direct human services and supports needed to address persistently low employment rates. In addition, ACCES oversees the Bureau of Proprietary School Supervision that licenses and monitors more than 400 non-degree post-secondary schools offering a full menu of career and beauty school programs; and the Adult Education Program and Policy office which includes the distribution of dedicated federal and state resources and manages the High School Equivalency program.

Prior to his service at NYSED, Mr. Smith served as Executive Director of Literacy New York, formerly known as Literacy Volunteers of America-New York, since 1982. Mr. Smith is a 1975 graduate of SUNY at Fredonia trained in Secondary Education/English. His accomplishments include: serving as a delegate to the 1991 White House Conference on Library Information and Services; member of the New York State Board of Regents Literacy Planning Committee; Chair of the State Literacy Council; member of the Adult Learning Services Council under two Commissioners of Education; Secretary of the National Commission on Adult Basic Education (COABE); New York Association Continuing/Community Education (NYACCE) Past-President; Lawrence Levin Professional Award winner; recipient of the Literacy Volunteers of America National Chair's Award; and, formally served as a NYATEP board member.
